a) general information:

- to strengthen abilities and to work out strong points, so the young people can actively and formatively approach their life situation
- reintegration in educational processes

5. Project description / Activities

examples of our life-practical offers and targeted qualification in single and group work:

- handicraft-practical: maintenance and renovating work of facilities of public interest housekeeping, etc.
- life-practical: information on relevant topics, PC-training, etc.
- qualification: mathematics, reading, writing, general education (politics, environment)
- group dynamical offers: excursions, visits to local enterprises, etc.
